

Australian Waterski and Wakeboard Federation

Membership Application/Renewal 1st October 2009 to 30th September 2010

Family.

A family membership is defined as a married or de facto couple and their junior children under 18 as at July 1st 2009.

Adult.

Single person over 18 at July 1st 2009

Junior

Single person under 18 at July 1st 2009

Non Skiing Official.

A person involved in the sport as an administrator, judge or similar who will not be competing in the current season. The category will qualify as a full member when Club Insurance is required.

Introductory Membership

Is a special first year membership available to new members or those who are rejoining after three or more years absence. Introductory members cannot compete at state, national or international competitions. However, membership may be upgraded at any time. (Includes Introductory Family)

Transition Membership

Is offered as an incentive for introductory members to renew their second year membership at a reduced rate during their transition from introductory to full membership. Transition members may compete at state titles, but not at a higher level event. However, membership may be upgraded at any time. (Includes Transition Family)

Social Membership

Previously called "Day Membership" and is predominantly for 'Come & Try' skiers. Social members may compete at club tournaments by invitation, but results are not recorded. The aim of this category is for the social skiers to join and receive selected benefits of AWWF membership while at the same time taking the opportunity to "Come and Try" one of the disciplines. Barefoot, Tournament, (Slalom, Trick, Jump) Wakeboard and Disabled. On joining through the AWWF office the Social member will receive a complimentary "Come and Try" certificate for use at tournaments or Come and try days. This can be used only once and is for two days.

Please note a Social Member is not able to hold AWWF administrative positions or officiate at Tournaments, and will not be recognized as a Full Member of the AWWF for Club Insurance reasons. Non Skiing Official is required as a minimum for this criteria.
